Canine Senior Wellness Program

We have developed a program that benefits your pet as well as your checkbook! The Senior Wellness Program is a comprehensive health program that screens your pet for conditions such as: obesity, periodontal disease, kidney disease, diabetes, liver disease, hypothyroidism, urinary tract infections, heartworm disease, high blood pressure, and intestinal parasites. This program can also be used to assess the patient prior to anesthesia for a professional dental cleaning or a surgical procedure.

The Animal Hospital of Colorado Springs has been offering a Senior Wellness Program since 2002. During this time, approximately 25% of the apparently healthy pets, who have done the program, were diagnosed with a condition which would have remained undetected until the pet became ill.

The goal of this program is PREVENTION. Many diseases, if detected early enough, can be cured or treated to stop or decrease the progression of the disease process. This means a happier and healthier pet. This program is only available at the time of a wellness exam and cannot be used for ill pets.
